Wicked-London Theatre Trip

We are offering the opportunity for Year 10 and 11 Music and Drama students to see a production of Wicked at the Apollo Theatre in London. This is an excellent opportunity to learn outside of the classroom and see a performance of the song 'Defying Gravity' that is part of the new G.C.S.E Music syllabus. Students will experience the eighth longest running musical currently in the West End.

The visit will take place on Wednesday 12th September 2018.

Students will leave school at **11am** and return by approximately **8.30pm** (TBC). Arrangements for students to be picked up by parents/carers must be made if students normally make use of the school bus.

The total cost of the trip will be £40.00 This is a self-financing trip, which will only go ahead if sufficient contributions are received.

Eligibility for Trips and Visits

Visits are viewed as rewards. Students are representing the school publicly and so students should only be rewarded with places on visits and trips if they:

- Have good attendance;
- Have good behaviour;
- Put effort into their work;
- Wear correct school uniform.

There are only 50 spaces available on this trip, therefore in the event of oversubscription after the aforementioned conditions have been applied, names will be drawn from a hat.
