The Woman in Black- London Theatre Trip

We are offering the opportunity for Year 9 English students to see a production of The Woman in Black at the Fortune Theatre in London. This is an excellent opportunity to learn outside of the classroom. They will witness first-hand the extraordinary theatre production of a text we will have studied in school. Furthermore, students will experience a West End production described as “brilliantly effective” and “one of British theatre’s biggest hits”.

The visit will take place on **Thursday 8th February 2018**.

Students will leave school at **11am** and return by approximately **8.30pm** (TBC). Arrangements for students to be picked up by parents/carers must be made if students normally make use of the school bus.

The total cost of the trip will be £36.00. This is a self-financing trip, which will only go ahead if sufficient contributions are received.

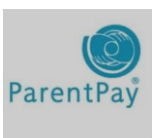
Eligibility for Trips and Visits
