### The Roundhill Academy Uniform Information

This letter provides parents with details of our school uniform. We are very conscious that in today's financial climate every penny counts and we feel our uniform represents very good quality and value for money. The Roundhill Academy works in partnership with Price & Buckland to supply our school uniform.

On the reverse of this letter is a list of our uniform items, some are mandatory items, which can only be purchased direct from our supplier; the school sweater, tie, sports polo shirt and one of the bottom garments, shorts, skirt or tracksuit bottoms. The sports hoodie is entirely optional. The school would recommend two sweaters, one tie and the sports polo shirt along with one of the bottoms should be enough to see a child through an academic year.

The remainder of the garments on the list can be purchased direct from Price & Buckland if parents so wish, but can also be purchased from the majority of all major retailers. Please be aware of the style of skirt that will be acceptable when purchasing from major retailers.

Price & Buckland have kindly offered to come to The Roundhill Academy to conduct **Try Before You Buy** evenings. These will take place in the Main Hall on **Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> June, 3:30pm-6pm**. You will be able to try the uniform for size and then complete an order form, which you will take home and order online. You may opt to have your order delivered to your home address for a small charge or alternatively you can have your order delivered to The Roundhill Academy free of charge during the summer holidays. If you are unable to attend the Try Before You Buy Evenings you will need to place your order directly on the Price & Buckland Website.

Orders placed to be delivered in to school will be available for collection between Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> July and Friday 9<sup>th</sup> August. Please note the last date for ordering for delivery in to school is Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July. For any orders placed after Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July parents will have to select home delivery as the next delivery date in to school will be Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> September. ## SCHOOL UNIFORM 2019/2020

The following list provides information on school uniform for all students. The school reserves the right to take disciplinary action against any child whose uniform does not comply with these requirements.

The judgement of the Principal will be final in these matters.

<b>JUMPER (Optional)</b>	<b>Dark navy/silver V-neck with school name may optionally be worn. No other jumper is permissible.</b>
<b>TROUSERS</b>	Classic suit style trousers in mid-grey. Tight fitting or cropped trousers are not acceptable. No stretch fabrics, jean style or turn ups. Belts must be plain black buckled. During hot weather tailored mid-grey shorts may be worn.
<b>SKIRT</b>	<u>A fully pleated knee length skirt in plain mid-grey.</u> The skirt should not be tightly tailored or of a stretchy "lycra" type material. It must not be split above the knee.
<b>SHIRT</b>	White shirt – must be tucked in at all times and the top button done up. Sleeves must not be rolled up but short sleeved shirts may be worn.
<b>TIE</b>	<b>Clip on school tie.</b>
<b>SOCKS</b>	Plain black, grey, navy or white. No trainer socks, no socks over tights.
<b>TIGHTS</b>	Plain black, natural, navy or grey. No leggings, footless tights or patterned tights. Tights or socks to be worn not both.
<b>FOOTWEAR</b>	Plain sensible flat black footwear, any logos must be black. Plain black boots are only acceptable when it has snowed.
<b>COAT</b>	Outdoor coats should be dark and plain in colour, compatible with our school uniform and discrete logos only. We do not consider sports tops, hoodies, fleeces, leather jackets, fur coats or denim jackets and other fashion items to be school uniform.
<b>PE KIT</b>	<b>Boys &amp; Girls compulsory items:</b> <b>Black sports polo shirt with white piping and school name</b> <b>Black shorts / skort / tracksuit bottom with white piping</b>  <b>Boys &amp; Girls optional items:</b> <b>Black sports zipped hoodie with school name</b> Black leggings / Black base layer Black sports socks Training shoes Football boots (boys only) A separate bag for PE kit should be used.
<b>JEWELLERY AND ACCESSORIES</b>	Two small studs or earrings in plain gold or silver. One nose stud. Tongue and Belly piercings are not allowed on the grounds of Health and Safety.
<b>MAKE-UP</b>	KS3 - Make-up and nail varnish are not to be worn to school. KS4 - Girls are permitted to wear a natural look foundation and mascara. Only clear nail varnish is permitted on a natural nail for school.
<b>HAIRSTYLES</b>	No unnatural or extreme hairstyles or colour.
<b>HAIR BANDS/RIBBONS etc.</b>	Plain black or navy.
<b>HEADWEAR</b>	Caps are not to be worn on the school site. Certain items of clothing/headwear are acceptable if they form part of religious observance. Parents should contact the school if they wish to discuss this with a senior member of staff.
<b>BAG</b>	Fit for purpose school bag to carry A4 books and all equipment.
